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Group Dynamic Title: SYNERGY IN ACTION (Group Exercise)

Learning Goals:

- To consolidate the concepts learned during the “Ecosystem services” and “Compensation actions” presentations.
- To link compensation actions to specific ecosystem services.
- To understand how combined compensation actions complement each other and the services they provide.

Background Information:

The aim of this exercise is to challenge participants to apply the knowledge gained in this session with creative thinking. The exercise is designed to allow a large amount of freedom for participants to draw their ideas and multiple correct conclusions, as long as they are well justified.

Prior Knowledge Needed *(For the facilitator):*

The facilitator should be familiarized with:

- Ecosystem services;
- Compensation actions and the services they benefit.

Support Material: A3 paper sheets; color markers

Duration: 1h20 – 1h30 minutes.

Age Range: Adults.



Instructions:

1. Create 4-5 random groups with an equal number of participants.
2. Open “Exercise 4_support” powerpoint.
3. Groups will select 3 compensation actions, and draw a simple scheme explaining how the different actions can complement each other and improve specific ecosystem services (*30 min*).
4. A spokesperson of each group presents their ideas. After each presentation, trainees and other participants can comment and offer their output. (*40-50 min; 5 min presentation+ 5 min discussion for each group*).
